

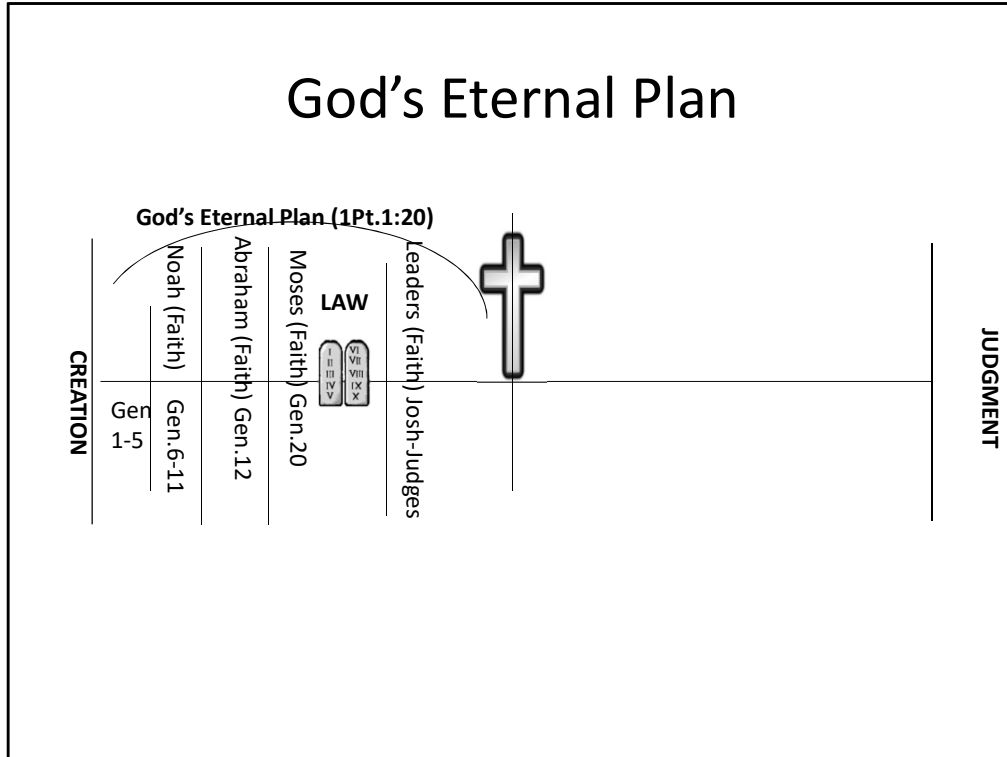
The Eternal Plan

Tonight we come to another period in the Bible known as the...

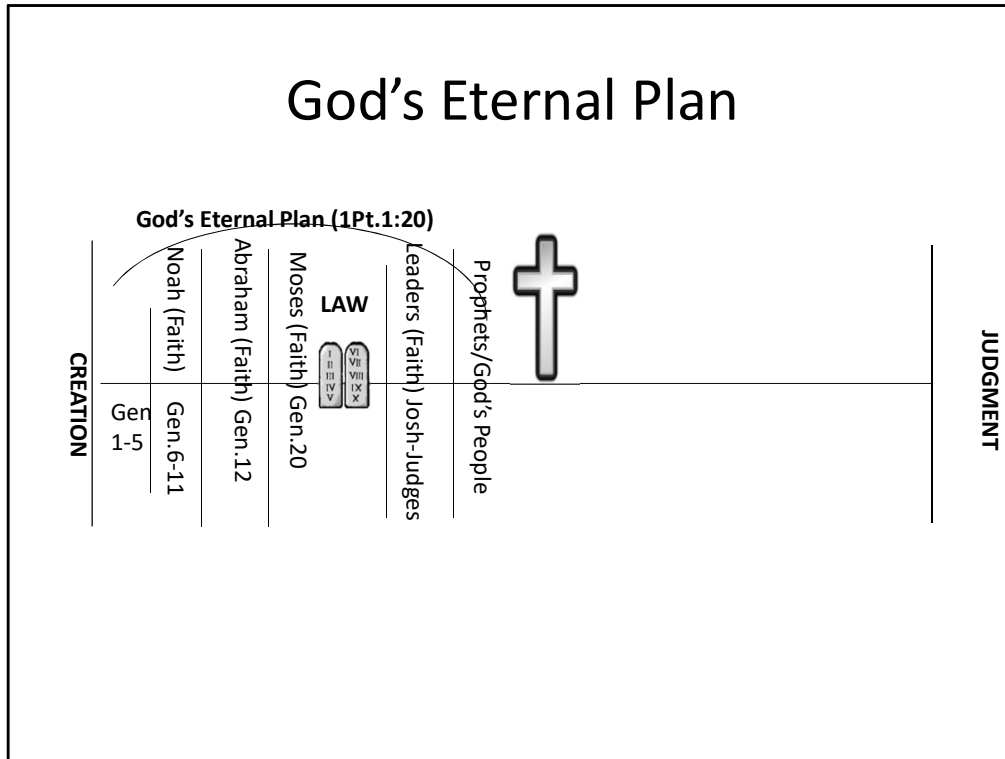
The Divided Kingdom Period

- From the Division of the kingdom to the Fall of Israel
- Scriptures covered are 1Kings 11:9 through 2Kings 18:12, 2Chron. 10 through 32:8
- Main Points:
 - The Cause of the Division 1Sam8; 1:kings 12
 - The Capitals 1Kings 12:26; 16:21-28
 - The List of Kings During This Period
